The Downtown Clubhouse Teen Room, run by April Ochoa, is a safe, private, fun place for teens to gather after school. April offers several BGCA designed programs throughout the week:

Power Hour / Teen Discussion Mon - Thu, 4:00 - 5:00pm

**Toastmasters**: Teens practice writing and public speaking skills.

**SMART Girls**: Health, fitness, prevention/education, and self-esteem enhancement programs for girls. The program is designed to encourage healthy attitudes and lifestyles.

**Games**: Youth challenge themselves by working in teams to win at popular games.

Political Animals/ Know Your Rights Group: Teens research current

political candidates and political stances that effect their daily lives. They hold mock debates and learn about the system that governs their lives. They also research what their rights are as students, as minors, as immigrants, and as young American citizens.

Passport to Manhood: This program fosters positive values and responsible behavior in boys 11 to 14 while giving them practice in making healthy decisions related to their physical, cognitive, emotional, and social development. As they build and practice life skills for decision-making, conflict resolution, and healthy relationships, boys learn the essential attitudes, values, and skills they need to become responsible adult men.

## **Bay View, Mission Hill and Gault Walking Bus**

Mission Hill Middle School walking bus details: Club staff will escort 6th, 7th & 8th graders from Mission Hill campus to the Club every day. Meet at the stairs out front on King St. This program is free of charge.
