Teen Programs

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Santa Cruz County is committed to serving teens and young adults with programs geared toward their needs and interests. This includes implementing programs and classes designed to empower youth to excel in school, become good citizens and lead healthy, productive lives.

Our teen center is a space within our clubhouse created especially for youth ages 13 - 18. It is a safe place, where youth can be themselves without feeling the pressure of being judged. Within our teen program, youth have access to resources and experiences that expose them to a world of opportunities. Plus, the program area is a comfortable place to hang out with friends, connect with caring mentors, and participate in fun activities like sports, arts and volunteerism.



Bay View, Westlake, Mission Hill and Gault Walking Bus

Club staff walk students to the Boys & Girls Club after school Mon - Fri. See front desk for registration. Elementary school bus is \$5/week, paid in advance. *ONLY registered members will be picked up at the elementary schools.*

Bay View: Club staff meet students by cafeteria doors to small parking lot at 2:45, depart at 3pm, and arrive at Club by 3:30pm. On Wednesdays, meet at 12:45, depart at 1p, arrive at Club by 1:30p.

Westlake: Bus starts walking at 2:25 (1st-3rd grade) and 2:45 (4th-5th graders) to arrive at Club by 3:30pm. Wednesdays, depart at 12:10 and 12:30.

Mission Hill Middle School: Club staff will escort 6th, 7th & 8th graders from Mission Hill campus to the Club every day. Meet at the stairs out front on King St. This program is free of charge.

Gault: Club staff meet students at picnic tables in school yard at 2:40, depart at 3pm, and arrive at Club by 3:45pm. On Wednesdays, meet at 12:30, depart at 12:50p, arrive at Club by 1:35p.


