

Summer Day Camp Overview

During the summer program at the Boys & Girls Clubs of Santa Cruz County, Club members are encouraged to participate in a variety of programs and activities that promote good character, academic success, personal responsibility, exploration and fun. While at the Club, members are placed in age appropriate groups and have scheduled time in each of our program areas, ensuring they receive a fulfilling, well rounded experience.

Program Highlights

- **Gardening/Green Team:** We will learn daily about how to keep our veggies alive as well as about plants/soil. We will taste new foods from our garden, talk about how to compost and learn how to be environmentally friendly! Please see Green Team flyer for more information
- **Technology program:** Daily computer activities will feature internet safety sessions, as well as other education-based game play. Our professional staff ensure Club members are receiving fun and educational screen time and provide excellent supervision for Club members while on the computers. (Staff present in lab at all times)
- **Creative Arts:** Members will work both individually and in groups to create works of art using a variety of mediums. Projects will include: collage, drawings, watercolor and acrylic painting, arts and crafts, group mural projects and much more.
- **Athletics:** Club members will participate in daily athletic activities in our movement room and outdoor play area. Members will participate in a fun filled summer of recreation games, skills building activities as well as opportunities to play on team sports.
- **D.E.A.R. (Drop Everything And Read):** Each day we will read and have quiet time from 1-2pm at the club to help prevent summer reading loss.
- **Swim:** For all ages in the Downtown Clubhouse's indoor, heated swimming pool (city bus trip). Bring swim gear (bathing suit & towel) Certified lifeguards are on duty at all times when pool area is open. Club members who wish to swim in the deep end must pass the swim test (testing available at the beginning of each swim time). Members who don't take and pass the swim test may play in the shallow end of the pool during their swim time.

Summer Brain Gain *ages 6 - 18 years old*

Prevent summer learning loss!

Summer Brain Gain focuses on reading, programming, activities, projects, and assessments.

All Club members will participate in our Brain Gain program. Classes are designed to be developmentally appropriate and help club members reach our priority outcome areas of Academic Success, Good Character and Citizenship, and Healthy Lifestyles.

Curriculum has been designed to engage members in hands on learning experiences that may include: Cooking gardening technology sports and fitness, art music performance and Community service.

Project Learn *ages 6-18 years old*

The Clubhouse will be implementing a Club-wide summer learning loss prevention program that focuses on hands-on, experiential learning through high yield learning activities. This initiative offers youth the opportunity to develop their skills in three outcome areas: Academic Success, Healthy Lifestyles and Good Character & Citizenship. Project Learn programs and activities are offered throughout the day for all youth participating in summer day camp.

Special Interest Classes

Smart Girls Ages: 8 – 10 | Cost: FREE

Interactive, engaging, small-group sessions engender camaraderie, while also encouraging girls to explore and express their individuality through discussions, hands-on games and activities, role-play, take-home challenges and activities, and collaborative decision-making and problem-solving.

Summer Beach Team Ages: all | Cost: \$5/day or \$50 for whole 10-week summer

A summer long commitment where we travel all over Santa Cruz County to help learn and beautify our community. We will travel by city bus to coastal locations including beaches.

Child must have lunch, backpack, water bottle, hat, suit and sunscreen for each trip. Good walking shoes is a must! Layers are important for this trip!

Summer Green Team Ages: all | Cost: \$5/day or \$50 for whole 10-week summer

A summer-long community service commitment visiting Henry Cowell State Park in Felton every week to provide community service such as: River clean up, trail care, helping visitors, eco-system help, brush clearing etc. There will always be some fun involved!

We will be taking the city bus to and from the park each day. **Child must have lunch, backpack, water bottle, hat, suit and sunscreen for each trip. Good walking shoes is a must!**

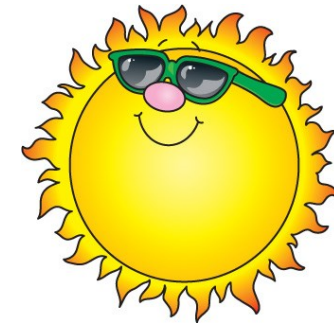
