Program Highlights

- **Open recreational swim:** Recreational swim is available for all Club members at Simpkins on Mondays from 1:00 - 3:30pm for \$5. You must pre-register at the front desk. Bring bathing suit & towel. Certified lifeguards are on duty at all times while Club members are swimming and present in the pool area. Club members who wish to swim in the deep end must pass the swim test. Swim tests are given at the beginning of each swim time. Members who are unable to pass the swim test or who do not wish to take it will remain in the shallow end of the pool during their swim time. Swim lessons, swim team, and water polo are available at the Downtown Clubhouse.
- **Technology program:** Daily computer activities will feature lessons on coding, Internet safety sessions, as well as other education-based game play. Our professional staff ensure Club Members are receiving fun and educational screen time and provide excellent supervision for Club Members while on the computers.
- **Creative Arts:** Members will work both individually and in groups to create works of art using a variety of mediums. Projects will include: collage, drawings, watercolor and acrylic painting, arts and crafts, group mural projects and much more.
- **Athletics:** Club Members will participate in daily athletic activities in our movement room and outdoor play area. Members will participate in a fun filled summer of recreation games, skills building activities as well as opportunities to play on team sports.

Prevent summer learning loss! Summer Brain Gain focuses on reading, programming, activities, projects, and assessments. All Club members will participate in our Brain Gain program.

Teen Center Summer Fun

Our Teen Center is open Monday thru Friday from 10:00 am—6:00 pm for Club members who are at least 11 years old and have will be going in to 6th grade in the fall. Members arriving before 10:00 will be subject to the \$15 per day fee.

Teen Center programming includes : Art STEM, Gardening, Cooking, Music, and much more
BGCA National programs we have for this summer:

Money Matters helps young people learn financial literacy, so they can make good financial choices as adults. Participants learn how to manage a checking account, create a budget, save and invest, start small businesses and pay for college. Teens who complete Money Matters show improved financial management skills, including saving money and sticking to a budget.

Junior Staff assists Club members ages 13 to 18 in exploring a career in youth or human services, particularly Boys & Girls Club work. Young people prepare for future roles as human services professionals by participating in career development activities, discovering the importance of community service, building customer service skills and completing a Club apprenticeship. The program develops Club members' interpersonal skills, work ethic and sense of community responsibility.



Mondays to the Dollar Tree – Bring some money for some treats at the Dollar Store. Teens are welcome to sign up in advance for swimming at Simpkins \$5.
Tuesdays alternate between going out to lunch – Bring \$15 for a lunch at one of our fine local restaurants and enjoying a movie at the Cinelux Theater– Bring \$10. for movie admission price . Movies will be announced the week prior according to the theaters listings. Members under 13 may not attend movies with a rating of PG13 without written permission from a parent or guardian

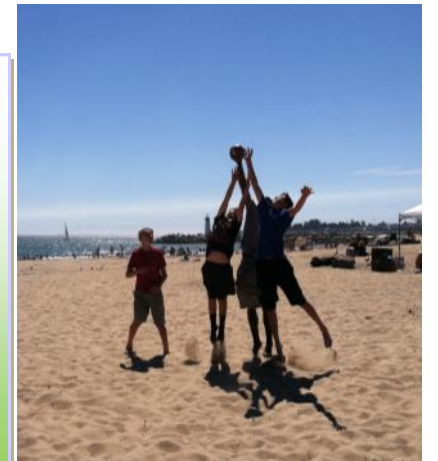
